## Trailer Towing Tips

Before you hit the road with your trailer or RV, be sure to keep these essential tips in mind:

- **Inspect your tires and wheels thoroughly** – Ensure there are no visible irregularities, unusual wear, or foreign objects lodged in the tread. Pay attention to sidewall cracks, bulges, or any damage. Protect your tires from sunlight when not in use.
- **Maintain proper tire pressure** – Tires lose pressure over time, especially with temperature fluctuations or when parked for long periods. Under inflated tires put extra strain on the tire shoulders, leading to uneven wear or poor handling. Always inflate your tires to the recommended level as indicated on your tire or RV/trailer's placard.
- **Check your wheels** – Ensure that the wheels and lug nuts/bolts on your RV or trailer are properly tightened to the recommended torque specification.
- **Know your trailer's load capacity** – Exceeding this capacity can result in excessive tire wear and reduced towing performance.
- **Distribute the weight evenly** – A tail-heavy trailer can cause instability and sway, especially at higher speeds. Aim to keep at least 60% of the load toward the front half of the trailer to maintain balance and improve handling.

By following these tips, you'll ensure a safer and smoother towing experience for both you and your tires.
